Dear Members,

This has been a significant year for the Gedney Association. We observed and celebrated our 100th anniversary in May, and after much review, our new stone entrance sign has been approved, with construction set to begin shortly. The stone sign will be located on Gedney Esplanade near Mamaroneck Avenue. The stone and bronze components are of the highest quality and are intended to last for many years. We believe it will offer Gedney Farms greater identity and embellish the value and character of our neighborhood.

The Farrell subdivision plan is in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) process. We understand that the applicant is undertaking requisite site testing and formalizing its responses to governmental and public comments received during the DEIS process.

One of the great attributes of our Association is its historical involvement in city-wide issues besides advocacy for our own neighborhood. In the past, The Association played a key role in defeating the “City within a City” proposal for the NY Hospital Campus, high-rise apartment buildings on Westchester Avenue and a proposed shopping Center on Mamaroneck Avenue near the Parkway.

The Board has set a fundraising goal of \$25,000 for our new stone signage. Kindly consider making a contribution to this effort that will accentuate the beauty and character of our neighborhood.
